1. Examine the following data of Middle English and Modern English. State, in prose, the changes that have occurred in the history of English based on these data. Make your statement as general as the data permit. Please also state the changes in terms of phonological rules. If rule ordering is significant, indicate the correct order of the rules. (20%)

- 2. A discourse is not just a collection of any sentences. The sentences in a discourse must be related to each other to be a coherent discourse. Examine the following discourses. Explain why some discourses you consider coherent and why the others you consider incoherent. And, for those incoherent ones, try to correct them and make them coherent. Please also explain why your corrections can render an incoherent discourse coherent. (20%)
  - (a) My mom will come to Chiavi to visit me tonight. I am going to meet her at Platform II.
  - (b) John arrived in Edinburgh by train. Max's hair was black.
  - (c) We went to an expensive restaurant last night. The waiter was very nice.
  - (d) We went to a movie last weekend. The gentleman was very nice.
  - (e) Jade's friend will come to Chiayi to visit her tonight. She will meet him at the convenience store.
- 3. Examine the following English data and, based on the data below, formulate rules to locate the antecedent for a reflexive. (30%)
- (a) Poirot<sub>i</sub> hurt himself<sub>i</sub>.
- (b) \*Miss Marple<sub>i</sub> hurt himself<sub>i</sub>.
- (c) \*Poirot<sub>i</sub> hurt herself<sub>i</sub>.

(d) \*Poirot<sub>i</sub> hurt themselves<sub>i</sub>.

- (e) \*Poirot<sub>i</sub> hurt myself<sub>i</sub>.
- (f) \*Poirot<sub>i</sub> thinks that Miss Marple hurt himself<sub>i</sub>.
- (g) Miss Marple thinks that Poirot<sub>i</sub> hurt himself<sub>i</sub>.
- (h) Poirot<sub>i</sub> invited himself<sub>i</sub>.
- (i) \*Poirot<sub>i</sub>'s sister invited himself<sub>i</sub>.

(j) [IP [NP; [NP; Poirot]'s brother] invited himself.]

(k) \*Poirot<sub>i</sub> believes [ $_{CP}$  that [ $_{IP}$  himself<sub>i</sub> to be the best]]. (l) \*Poirot<sub>i</sub> believes [NP Miss Marple's description of himself<sub>i</sub>]. (m) Poirot<sub>i</sub> believes [NP any description of himself<sub>i</sub>].

(n) Miss Marple believes [NP Poirot<sub>i</sub>'s description of himself<sub>i</sub>]. Then, examine the following data of reciprocal verbs in Mandarin. With respect to locating antecedents, reciprocals are considered the same as reflexives. Can your rules for English reflexives also work for the data on Mandarin reciprocal verbs? Explain your answer. How does duifang 'the other, each other' in the following data find its antecedent? (RCP is an abbreviated form for reciprocal prefix.)

- (o) [zhangsan lisi]<sub>i</sub> hu-cheng duifang<sub>i</sub> **RCP-call** Zhangsan Lisi each other '[Zhangsan and Lisi]<sub>i</sub> address to each other<sub>i</sub> good friends.' 張三李四互稱對方為好朋友。
- (p) [zhangsan lisi]<sub>i</sub> hu-cheng [wangwu zha Zhangsan Lisi RCP-claim Wangwu Zha '[Zhangsan and Lisi]; claimed that [Wangwu and 張三李四互稱王五趙六知道對方作弊。
- (q) [zhangsan lisi]<sub>i</sub> hu-cheng [wangwu zhaoliu]

'[Zhangsan and Lisi]<sub>i</sub> claimed that [Wangwu and Zhaoliu]<sub>i</sub> knew that [Xiaomei and Axin]<sub>k</sub> saw that each other i/\*i/\*k cheated.
