1. Examine the following data of Middle English and Modern English. State, in prose, the changes that have occurred in the history of English based on these data. Make your statement as general as the data permit. Please also state the changes in terms of phonological rules. If rule ordering is significant, indicate the correct order of the rules. (20%)

2. A discourse is not just a collection of any sentences. The sentences in a discourse must be related to each other to be a coherent discourse. Examine the following discourses. Explain why some discourses you consider coherent and why the others you consider incoherent. And, for those incoherent ones, try to correct them and make them coherent. Please also explain why your corrections can render an incoherent discourse coherent. (20%)

- (a) My mom will come to Chiayi to visit me tonight. I am going to meet her at Platform II.
- (b) John arrived in Edinburgh by train. Max's hair was black.
- (c) We went to an expensive restaurant last night. The waiter was very nice.
- (d) We went to a movie last weekend. The gentleman was very nice.
- (e) Jade's friend will come to Chiayi to visit her tonight. She will meet him at the convenience store.

3. Examine the following English data and, based on the data below, formulate rules to locate the antecedent for a reflexive. (30%)

- (a) Poirot_i hurt himself_i.
- (b) *Miss Marple_i hurt himself_i.
- (c) *Poirot_i hurt herself_i.

- (d) *Poirot_i hurt themselves_i.
- (e) *Poirot_i hurt myself_i.
- (f) *Poirot_i thinks that Miss Marple hurt himself_i.
- (g) Miss Marple thinks that Poirot_i hurt himself_i.
- (h) Poirot_i invited himself_i.
- (i) *Poirot_i's sister invited himself_i.
- (j) [_{IP} [_{NP_i} [_{NP_i} Poirot]']s brother] invited himself_j].
- (k) *Poirot_i believes [_{CP} that [_{IP} himself_i to be the best]]].
- (l) *Poirot_i believes [_{NP} Miss Marple's description of himself_i].
- (m) Poirot_i believes [_{NP} any description of himself_i].
- (n) Miss Marple believes [_{NP} Poirot_i's description of himself_i].

Then, examine the following data of reciprocal verbs in Mandarin. With respect to locating antecedents, reciprocals are considered the same as reflexives. Can your rules for English reflexives also work for the data on Mandarin reciprocal verbs? Explain your answer. How does *duifang* 'the other, each other' in the following data find its antecedent? (RCP is an abbreviated form for reciprocal prefix.)

- (o) [zhangsan lisi]_i hu-cheng duifang_i wei hao pengyou
Zhangsan Lisi RCP-call each other as good friend
'[Zhangsan and Lisi]_i address to each other_i good friends.'
張三李四互稱對方為好朋友。
- (p) [zhangsan lisi]_i hu-cheng [wangwu zhaoliu]_j zhidoa duifang_{i/*j} zuobi
Zhangsan Lisi RCP-claim Wangwu Zhaoliu know each other cheat
'[Zhangsan and Lisi]_i claimed that [Wangwu and Zhaoliu]_j knew that each other_i cheated.'
張三李四互稱王五趙六知道對方作弊。
- (q) [zhangsan lisi]_i hu-cheng [wangwu zhaoliu]_j zhidoa [xiaomei he axin]_k ...
Zhangsan Lisi RCP-claim Wangwu Zhaoliu know Xiaomei and Axin ...
see each other cheat
'[Zhangsan and Lisi]_i claimed that [Wangwu and Zhaoliu]_j knew that [Xiaomei and Axin]_k saw that each other_{i/*j/*k} cheated.'
張三李四互稱王五趙六知道小美和阿信看到對方作弊。

5. What are the thematic structures of the verbs in the following sentences? Why do you think so? Elaborate. (20%)

- (a) John swam in the big swimming pool in the park.
- (b) Mary jogged in the park.
- (c) John found Mary's watch in the closet.
- (d) John planted several trees into his backyard.
- (e) John watched TV in his big house.
