If you were asked to provide language education advice to a group of parents who were considering putting their children in English-only or bilingual kindergartens, what kind of advice and reasoning would you give to them?
- 2. If you were an elementary school teacher in Taiwan and a textbook dealer is trying to sell you some of their American ESL textbooks, what criteria would you use to evaluate the textbooks? Under what conditions would you agree to adopt any of the imported textbooks for your EFL classes?
