一、Development Policies and Characteristics :

The Department of Development Policy is to combine classical literature and modern literature, integrate traditional and modern academic, inherit Chinese culture, and develop humanities-based technology and to nurture talents of Chinese literature.

二、Course Objectives :

1. To cultivate students become scholar who have self-introspection, concern social and cultural skills, based on local, and mind the Central Plains, a broad vision of a new generation of literature people.
2. To train students have academic research ability.
3. To prepare students have Mandarin language teaching capability.
4. To cultivate student become talents who will do language creation and application, and preserve and spread Chinese culture.

三、Basic Ability Index :

1. Being able to criticize moral reflection and strong assimilative capacity and have human qualities of diversity and elegant.
2. Being able to communicate and cooperate with people.
3. Have knowledge of local culture, Chinese culture, and multi-culture in the world.
4. Being able to discover discovery, analyze and solve problems skills.
5. Being able to give lectures and writing reports.
6. Being able to do Chinese academic research.
7. Have knowledge of Taiwan literature and modern literature.
8. Have knowledge of Chinese language, literature, thinking.
9. Being able to teaching Chinese language.
10. Have skills of Chinese writing, creation and applications.
11. Being able to use computer.
12. Being able to do edition, interview, advertising planning, and theater writing.
13. Have knowledge of cultural property preservation and patient of spreading Chinese culture.

Provision of study :

Graduate credit :

Students must have at least 128 credits, in which including required 54 credits, 44 elective credits and required general course 30 credits.

Other Help :

1. Excess credit of General Education credits may not offset the graduation credits.
2. If students give up the education program, those credits in teacher education program may not offset graduate credit.
3. Military training or sophomore junior and senior physical education credits may not offset graduate credits.
4. Elective course credits of other department can be admitted to this department courses only 15 credits.
