

Memorandum of Understanding Between



College of Life Science, National Chiayi University, Taiwan and

Faculty of Agriculture, Chiang Mai University, Thailand

- 1. The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to promote both of the educational and academic collaborations between College of Life Science, National Chiayi University (herein referred to as NCYU) and Faculty of Agriculture, Chiang Mai University, Thailand (herein referred to as CMU). NCYU and CMU agree to conduct the following objectives
 - a. Promoting student exchange programs;
 - b. Promoting undergraduate and postgraduate programs;
 - c. Promoting institutional exchange by inviting faculties and staffs to participate in joint academic activities;
 - d. Promoting institutional exchange by inviting faculties and staffs to participate in joint research projects;
 - e. Promoting institutional exchange by inviting faculties and staffs to participate in joint scientific publications;
- 2. In accordance with the principle of mutual and equal benefit, international travel expenses, cost of living, health insurance or other necessary expenses incurred by the visiting scholars (students) will be borne by the individual visitors, unless provided by specific arrangements
- 3. NCYU and CMU agree to assist each other in drawing up and carrying out the concrete plan of the collaboration scheme stated in the objectives of this MOU. Details of these plans will be set up in a separate addendum to this memorandum
- 4. This MOU will be valid for 5 (five) years starting the date of signing by the official representatives of both parties, and shall be renewed with the approval of both authorized officials from both parties. If either party wants to terminate this MOU before the period of 5 (five) years, written notice needs to be given to the other party six months before the termination of the signed MOU. However, the ongoing projects should be continued to the end and not be affected by the termination of the MOU.
