

Memorandum of Understanding Between Faculty of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Environment, Naresuan University, Thailand and College of Life Sciences, National Chiavi University, Taiwan.



Faculty of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Environment, Naresuan University, Thailand and College of Life Sciences, National Chiayi University, Taiwan seek to enhance relations between the two parties by developing academic collaboration and exchange in teaching, research, training and other activities.

Within the framework of the regulations applying in each institution and subject to the availability of resources, the following programs and activities will be encouraged:

- A) Exchange of faculty members and research scholars for teaching and research
- B) Exchange of students for study, cooperative education and research
- C) Joint degree programs
- D) Joint research activities and publications
- E) Participation in seminars, conferences, and academic meetings
- F) Exchange of information, documents, publications, and other research material

The specific areas and details of cooperation within the framework of this agreement shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate authority of each party prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity. These will be constituted in an Addendum to this Memorandum of Understanding.

Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

This Memorandum will enter into effect from the date duly signed by the designated officials of the respective institutions. The effective period is five years and it will be extended automatically as long as neither party expresses a desire to terminate or modify this Memorandum. Should either institution wish to terminate this Memorandum, a written notice should be given six months in advance of the desired termination date.
