GUIDELINES for Submission of Abstracts:

Abstracts must:

- Be clear and concise, between 150-250 words.
- Include a title formatted in Title Case, not UPPERCASE.
- Include a list of all authors' complete name, designation, and institutional affiliation
The composition of the abstract and the scientific focus of the research must:
- Clearly articulate the problem of interest and a well-defined purpose;
- Include objectives that advance the empirical or conceptual understanding of the problem;
- Employ research and/or theoretical methods appropriate for the problem and questions raised;
- Include background information relevant to previous literature and broader issues and themes;
- Represent a contribution to the field of study.

Submissions:

- All abstracts/full papers must be received by the Conference Committee
STARTING 20 AUGUST 2019
DEADLINE for submission is 15 SEPTEMBER 2019
- The Conference Committee in MJU is responsible for selecting papers for presentation and allocating them time to a program session.
- Authors whose abstract will be selected (on the basis of abstract topic and quality of submissions) will give a 15-minute oral presentation about their research and participate in a facilitated group discussion.
- Authors will receive an email confirming the receipt of their submission **ON OR BEFORE 16 SEPTEMBER 2019**
Authors whose abstracts have been accepted must submit to the Conference Committee the full paper by **15 SEPTEMBER 2019**.
- Any changes in the presentation details (e.g., name, title) and or presenter **after 18 SEPTEMBER 2019** will no longer be entertained.
