This course encourages and prepares future early childhood education practitioners to be sensitive to cultural and social needs of their diverse pupil population by examining the relationships between education and society. In this course, students will be introduced to basic theoretical perspectives of sociology. A variety of issues of sociology that permeate all social interactions in school and school-related environments will also be discussed, such as, but not limited to, social stratification, social reproduction, social capital, student-teacher relationship, and issues related to race, class, gender, and culture.
