Dieting in a scientific way is catching on. To stay a healthy weight, people used to hold the belief that calories in equal calories out. However, recent research has revealed that you can choose a more scientific approach to stay fit. If you are a middle-aged man whose middle is spreading, it may not just be that you are exercising less and eating more, but that you are making too much of the female hormone, estrogen. The extra estrogen encourages more fat to be laid down around the middle. Some doctors prescribe a testosterone supplement to give male patients more energy and help them build muscles. Males with muscles burn more calories and lose weight more quickly.

Another option is to take Vitamin D. During the summer of 2008, in a small trial of 38, a researcher from University of Minnesota reported those with more Vitamin D in their blood lost more weight. Other trials, too, have linked high Vitamin D levels with less obesity. The theory is simple. Because sunlight is the main source of vitamin D, a low level of vitamin D may make the body think that colder weather is on the way, and therefore that it has to store more food. A daily dose of 1000 International Units over several months would raise your blood level by 10ng/ml, meaning you could lose an extra two kilos on top of what you would expect to on your diet.
