Otherwise known as "lean finely textured beef," pink slime refers to the product that results when a beef producer takes the fat trimmings from beef to use as a hamburger filler.
To make the trimmings safe from E. coli and Salmonella, they have to be treated with ammonium hydroxide, a mixture of ammonia and water, and the bacteria is killed. Once used only in pet food and cooking oil, pink slime
is now found in a large (but unknown) percentage of the ground beef sold in supermarkets and served in fast food restaurants.
Gross? Yes, pink slime is disgusting. No one wants to think about anything being in their burger except actual meat. Now the biggest concern with pink slime is that we're buying (or eating) a product and we don't exactly know what it's made of. How on earth can we avoid it?
